The Director of Medical Imaging is responsible for working in a collaborative model of partnered leadership with the Department Head of Medical Imaging to manage the human, physical and financial resources of the service. Primary areas of responsibility will include but not be limited to; Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), Computerized Tomography (CT) Scanning, Interventional Radiology, General Radiology, Ultrasound, Mammography and Medical Imaging Information Systems (MIIS). In keeping with the values of compassion, respect, collaboration, knowledge and stewardship, the incumbent will be responsible and accountable for all aspects of operations.

The successful candidate will possess a passion for patient and family centred care, continuous improvement, and commitment to learning, the ability to build collaborative relationships and have a participative management style.
