I understand that “For the safety of the public and to preserve the professional integrity of our profession, it is required by law to register with the CAMRT and the NSAMRT in order to practice as a Medical Radiation Technologist in the province of Nova Scotia.” This is enforced under the Medical Radiation Technologists Act cited as R.S.N.S, 1967, chapter 180, Letters Patent By-Laws.

Furthermore, I understand that *before* I commence work I must have confirmation from NSAMRT of registration to practice. Please allow up to four weeks for processing of application and payment.

Upon registration with the NSAMRT, you will receive an email requesting you to follow a link to create an online account and pay annual (prorated) dues. This is a required portion of your registration and you are required to keep your account current as your job position, education and contact info changes throughout your registration with NSAMRT.

You are required to keep your file with CAMRT up to date as well.

Such data assists in obtaining pertinent statistics and helps your professional organizations and government project staffing needs, thus supply training and education as required.
