The Atlantic Medical Radiation Technologists Conference (AMRTC) is now accepting online submissions of abstracts for poster presentations to be presented at our 2nd biennial conference being held April 24th-25th in Moncton, New Brunswick. The AMRTC is Eastern Canada's conference for MRTs. The theme of the conference, **Better Together: FOSTERING COLLABORATION IN MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGY** is meant as a celebration of the great care MRTs provide across the healthcare spectrum. There will be educational opportunities for fostering teamwork and overcoming team dysfunction, learning how you show up as a teammate, tools for maintaining healthy workplace relationships, the power of conflict and strategies for difficult conversations, support for conflict resolution, and recognizing workplace dynamics. Important Information

The abstract submissions should be no longer than 325 words. Abstracts should not include authors or organizations in the text. Please format your abstract with the following headlines: Background, Methods, Results, Conclusion/Future Directions.

Research Topics

Submitted abstracts should identify which AMRTC Program area related to:

- Team-Work and Leadership
- Mental Health and Healthcare
- Caring and Empathy
- Interprofessionalism
- Medical Radiation Technology
- Resilience

Additional Information

- All presenters accepted through the abstract submission process and/or presenting at the conference *must register for and pay* to attend the conference and are responsible for their own related expenses. There is no registration fee for members of the NBAMRT, NLAMRT, NSAMRT or PEIAMRT.
- All abstracts must be submitted to info@nsamrt.ca
- Accepted abstracts will be published in the conference program which will be distributed to the conference delegates by email.
- Abstract submissions should be for research that is either complete, or will be complete, by the conference date.
- Avoid specialized jargon and undefined abbreviations. Do not include tables, figures, diagrams, footnotes, references, or acknowledgements in the text of the abstract.

Evaluation Criteria for Oral and Poster Submissions

Using a blinded review process, the Abstract Review Committee will review oral and poster abstracts using the following criteria:

- The abstract is clear and well organized;
- The proposed poster is innovative and/or original; and
- The proposed poster will be of significant interest to medical radiation technologists
