## **Nomination Requirements**

- A nomination form must be filled out (**see attached**)
- The nominee must be a full member in good standing
- **Deadline: April 7th**

A nominee can self-nominate, or a candidate can consent to be nominated by another member.

Along with the nomination form a short biography and a headshot is required, these will appear by your name on the electronic voting system.
