Policy: Registrants of NSAMRT must meet the criteria as set out in this policy to be approved for a license to work as a MRT in the province of Nova Scotia.

Rationale: As the medical radiation technologist regulator for the province of Nova Scotia it is the mandate of NSAMRT to ensure those granted a license to practice have meet a minimum standard. This standard ensures all MRTs have the requisite knowledge, skills, judgment and good character to provide the public with competent professional care.

Procedure: As outlined in the registration documents all applicants must provide required proof of meeting the following standards;

- Successful completion of an approved medical radiation technology program in the specified discipline(s).
- Successful completion of the CAMRT entrance to practice exam in the selected discipline(s) or the examination of the Ordre des Technologues en Imagerie Medical en Radiooncologie et en Electrophysiologie Medicale du Quebec (OTIMROEPMQ).
- Copy of government issued photo ID
- Documentation of name change if current name does not match submitted documents
- Legal entitlement to work in Canada
- English Language proficiency in reading and writing
- Good Character via submission of a criminal record and vulnerable sector check
- Clinical practice hours within the past 5 years
- Registration with CAMRT
- If transferring from another regulated jurisdiction evidence of good standing
